

## A winter tax break

With the start of another heating season, Arrowhead Electric Cooperative, Inc. would like to again remind our residential customers who have electric heat as a primary heat source that their heat is exempt from Minnesota sales tax, November through April.

The exemption only applies to electricity used as your primary fuel for residential heating; the property can not be considered rental property. If you have two heat meters, only one heat meter is tax exempt. Electricity from lights, appliances, etc. is not tax exempt.

Arrowhead Electric must charge sales tax unless we have a Sales Tax Exemption Certificate on file. If you qualify for the heat tax exemption please complete and send in the form below. If you are not certain you qualify check out [www.taxes.state.mn.us](http://www.taxes.state.mn.us), Residential Utilities. If you find you qualify and are not sure if you have already submitted this certificate, contact our billing office at 218-663-7239 or 1-800-864-3744.

***If you have already signed the Sales Tax Exemption Certificate you are already tax exempt. There is no need to renew this tax break annually, once the Certificate is on file you're good to go!***
